CYCLONE WINSTON REPORT

- 19th February 2016 - School Declared as an Evacuation centre
- 20th February 2016 - 3 families moved in before the cyclone hit. The cyclone hit us at 7: 00 p.m .
2 families moved in during the cyclone and a further 8 families moved in early Sunday morning bringing the total number of evacuees to 51.
The school also provided shelter to commuters who were stuck because of fallen trees and power posts.
- 21st February 2016 - Sangam CEO Mr. Jai Narayan and General Secretary Mr. Damend Goundar visited the school for a survey. The evacuees also received the first help from them. Head Teacher and members of the management visited students home for an initial assessment.
